

Hello VRC Families,

We hope everyone is enjoying their summer! Please see below for information regarding this preseason ice. If you have any questions please don't hesitate to ask.

General information

Ice Breakers are optional, by donation on-ice sessions held in the preseason. The coaches are provided by VRC. They are intended to socialize players and make the transition back into the season as smooth as possible. Ice Breakers are unrelated to team placement.

Tier 1 tryouts will occur in August and all participants will need to fill out a new registration form as confirmation of attendance as well as complete payment of \$125.00 as set by VIAHA. A \$50.00 deposit has already been paid for those players previously registered in T1 tryouts.

All other team placements will happen in September. Please continue reading for divisional notes.

Full ice hockey gear is required by all players on the ice.

Initiation (2013/14)

Free open house skate with VRC coaches for both new and registered Initiation kids on Aug 24th. Session registration is easy to do in advance by email to deputyregistrar@racquetclubkings.com.

There will also be an Ice Breaker session on August 25th for VRC players with registration available on our website.

Novice (2011/12)

Players are encouraged to attend summer Ice Breaker sessions for some hockey fun. There are no tryouts for Novice aged players, the teams will be scheduled practice times by birth year starting in September.

Atom (2009/10)

Ice Breakers are a chance to get skating, to see and make friends at the rink, as well as ensure all gear fits and is in good working order. Please register in advance on the web. The Atom team placement process is slated for the first week of September.

Pee Wee (2007/08)

Ice Breaker sessions are open to registration online by all players Tiers 1, 2 and 3 within the Pee Wee division. Tier 2/3 team placement will occur in the first week of September. Tier 1 tryouts will occur in the last week of August. All Tier 1 participants must have filled out the confirmation form and paid the \$125 tryout fee before stepping on the ice.

Bantam (2005/06)

The Bantam Tier 1 team will begin skating in the summer with all scheduled sessions considered mandatory unless otherwise agreed to in consultation with the head coach. Bantam players are required to complete club registration and Tier 1 payment of \$125 online before stepping on the ice
